### **Interesting highlights.**

1976: First published article was in *Seventeen Magazine* when I won a teen diet advice contest. Then food editor Olga Rigsby chose my column ‘The Diet Shelf’ about keeping food portions for the day on one shelf of the fridge to organize and prevent eating other ‘non diet’ foods.

1980-something: Because of my CNN reporting on international nutrition issues I was invited to the White House by UNICEF officials for a reception honoring UNICEF’s global nutrition efforts. I met President Bill Clinton and First Lady Hillary Clinton.

1999 – I traveled to Vietnam with a Culinary Institute of America group to produce a two-part program on culinary tourism to Vietnam for CNN Travel Now. We traveled the country from Saigon to Hanoi. The food was fabulous especially shared in the company of fellow foodies.

2001- I was invited to moderate a panel called “Nutrition Business and Health” in St. Petersburg, Russia. My panelists were Dr. Dean Ornish, Dr. Ken Cooper and a retired director of the World Health Organization. The meeting was Pepsico’s Top to Top conference, which is held every other year. Other attendees included former President George W. Bush, Mrs. Barbara Bush, Henry Kissinger, other world leaders and presidents of major food and consumer products companies including Walmart, Subway, 7-11, Aramark and Asda. The other invited moderator was Sir David Frost!!

2011- One of 25 global health journalists chosen for a United Nations Foundation Fellowship to cover the United Nations General Assembly, September 18-21. The 2011 theme was health, specifically the challenge to treat and prevent non-communicable diseases.

2012: Adjunct Professor of Journalism, Emory University Journalism 201:“News Writing and Reporting” Atlanta, GA

Mentorship: I have invited more than 30 students, interns, and young professionals in the food and nutrition fields to spend a week or more with me to learn about nutrition communications. I’ve learned much from them!
